

MERRICK PLACE

The history of Merrick Place is woven into the rich traditions of Kentucky. Located where Belle and J. Cal Milam once raised thoroughbred horses, the community derives its character from some of its famous early residents: **Exterminator**, winner of the 1918 Kentucky Derby; **Tut Tut**, who won every race he entered as a two-year-old; **Anna M. Humphrey**, also unbeaten as a two-year-old; and **Dust Flower**, winner of the 1922 Flashstakes – were all Milam horses.

But most famous of all was the legendary **Merrick**, after whom the Milams named their farm. Winner of 62 races, this handsome steed finished in the money 157 times. A stone commemorating Merrick adorns the lawn in front of the Merrick Inn.

The Milam's original antebellum manor house has since become the **Merrick Inn Restaurant** – the focal point of Merrick Place. For dining in Central Kentucky's finest tradition, the warm, unhurried atmosphere of the Inn is unbeatable. Private parties rooms and meeting rooms are available to Merrick Place residents.

For those who enjoy the active life, Merrick offers **lighted tennis courts** and **practice backboard**, a **basketball court**, a **sand volley ball court** an **Olympic-sized swimming pool** with wading pool and playground, and a **free-form pool** – intimate and tropical – behind the Inn.

It's great to be on foot at Merrick Place. You'll enjoy **award-winning landscaping** amid **rolling hills**, **secluded courtyards** and **shaded walkways** where thoroughbred horses like the fabled Merrick once played.

A variety of floor plans are available, in both apartment and townhouse styles. You'll notice it isn't the measure of a room that makes it spacious, it's usable wall space. And Merrick's floor plans provide for plenty of storage. Plus, mail is delivered right to your front door.

Quick and easy access to all of Lexington is available via the nearby beltline freeway system. Shopping, dining, schools, churches and professional services are within walking distance.
